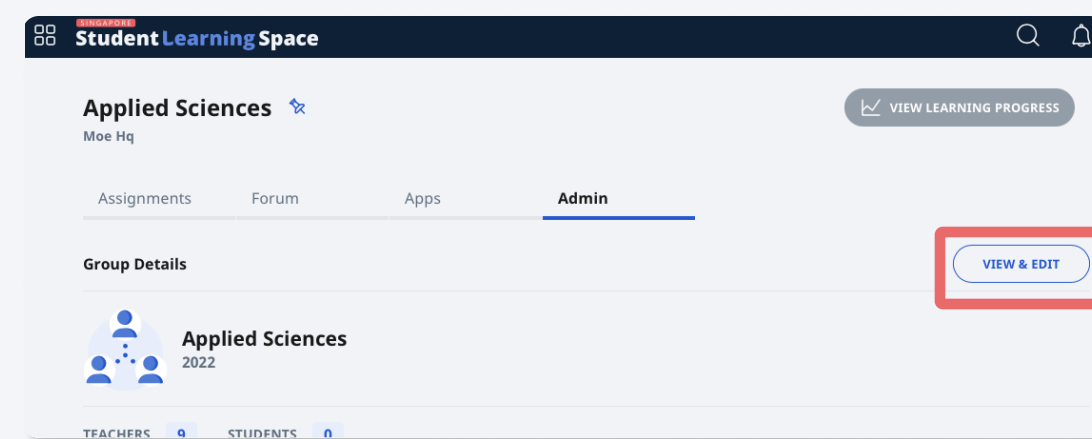

What is it? Learning Progress is a feature that allows teachers to monitor students' learning based on their mastery of questions attempted in assignments. To make the most of this feature, teachers should ensure that questions are tagged to the subject's Content Map, and included as part of Learning Progress calculation.

Add Subject to Teacher-Created Class Group

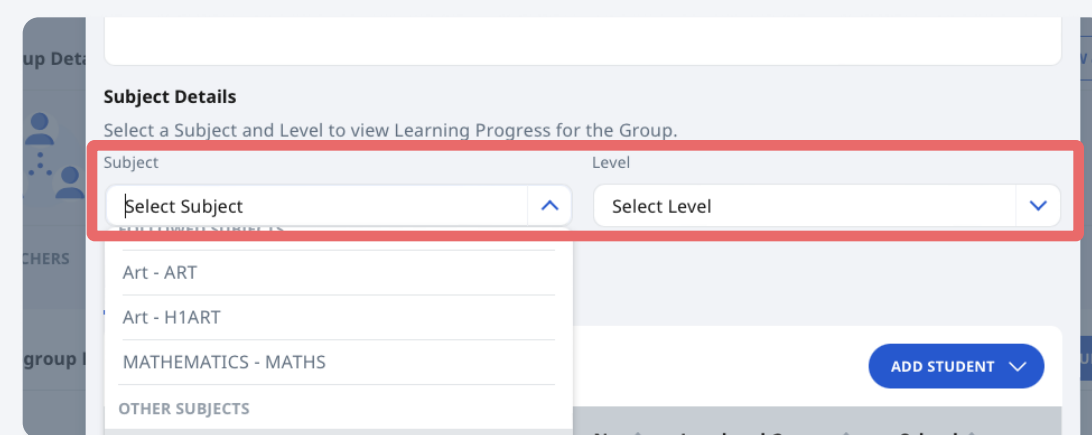
Only class groups assigned from the School Cockpit will have the Learning Progress feature enabled by default. You must add ONE subject and level to Teacher-created Class Groups to be able to track Learning Progress data.

- 1 Go to your Teacher-Created Class Group



Admin Tab of Class Group > Click "View & Edit"

- 2 Indicate Subject and Level on "Edit Details"



Select a Subject and Level to start tracking Learning Progress for the Class Group

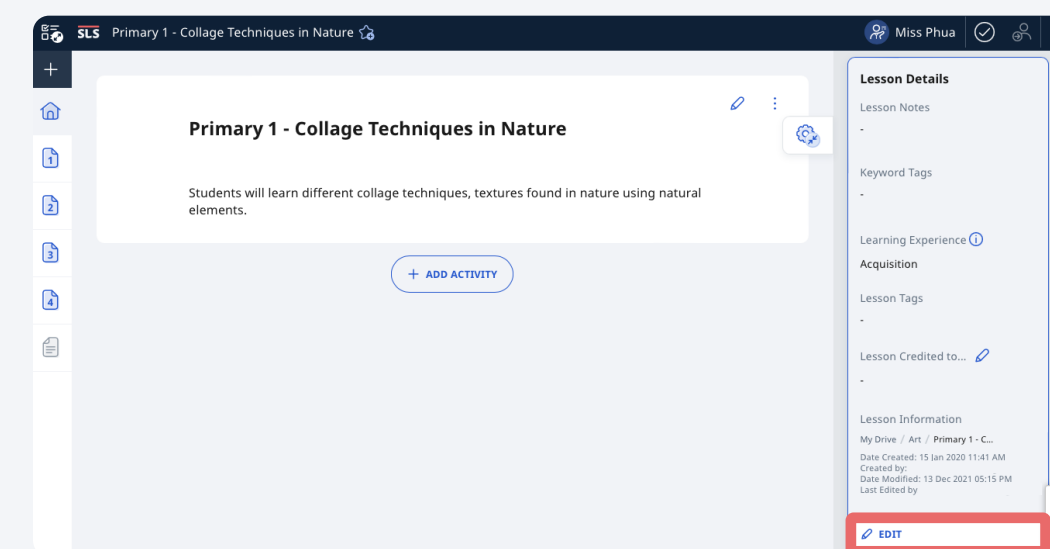
Tag & Include Questions in Learning Progress

Tag Questions in your Lesson/Course

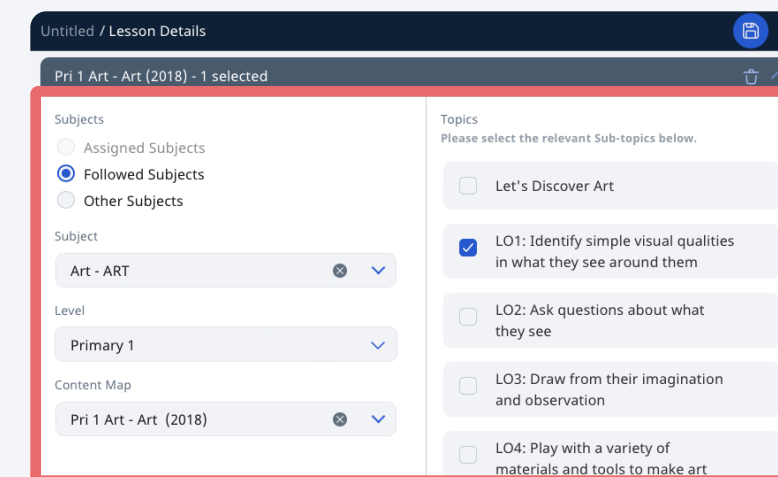
Each question allows you to tag it to a **Subject, Level, Content Map and Topic/ Sub-topic**. A question must be tagged to all four fields in order for teachers to track students' mastery on Learning Progress. Note that Poll and Interactive Thinking Tool components cannot be tagged.

Questions must be awarded marks for them to be reflected in Learning Progress.

- 1 Edit your Lesson/Course (before assigning) or your Assignment and click "Edit" on the Lesson/Course Details Card



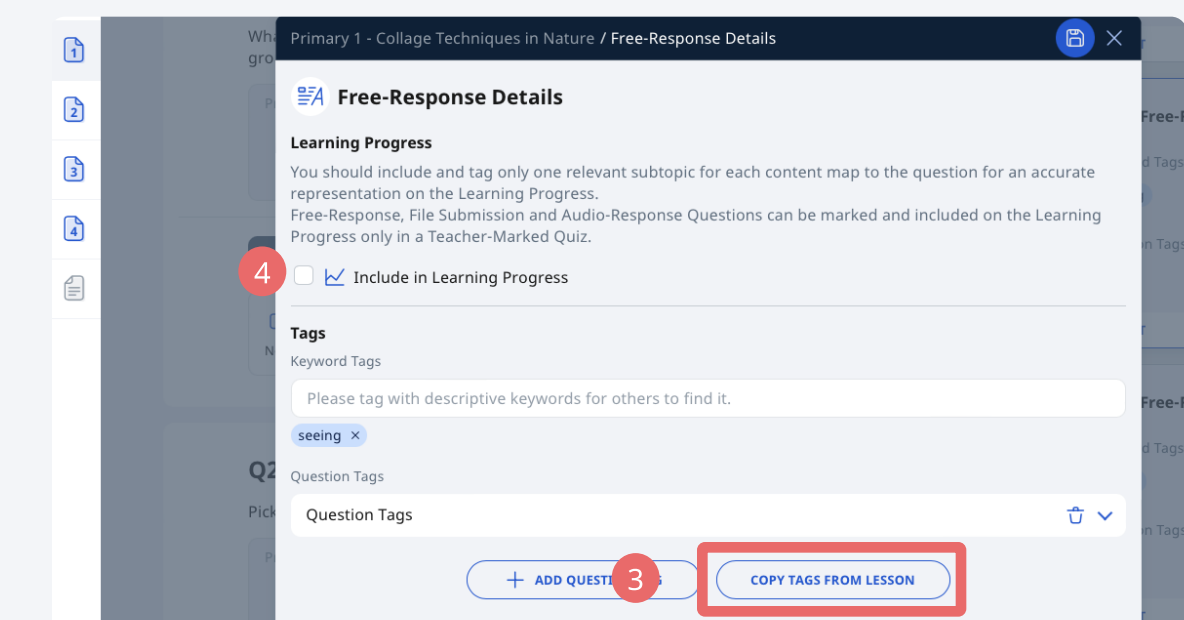
- 2 Tag your Lesson/ Course with the Subject, Level, Content Map, and Topic/ Sub-topic.



- 3 Tag the questions in your assignment with the relevant topic/ sub-topic, or copy the tags from your Lesson/Course.

Each question should be tagged to one topic/sub-topic only. Tagging questions to more than one topic/sub-topic will result in inaccurate data as the marks will be counted more than once.

- 4 Check the box "Include in Learning Progress" for each of your questions. You can also do this quickly in a quiz.



- 5 You can also do this quickly in a quiz by clicking on "Apply to All Questions" and "Include in Learning Progress" in Quiz Details.
